UNEA 5.2 - Legally binding instrument on plastic pollution to:

"promote sustainable production and consumption of plastics through, among other things, product design and **environmentally sound waste management**, including through resource efficiency and circular economy approaches". (Resolution 5/14, 3(b))

Basel Convention (Article 2.8)

"Environmentally sound management of hazardous wastes or other wastes' means taking all practicable steps to ensure that hazardous wastes or other wastes are managed in a manner which will protect human health and the environment against the adverse effects which may result from such wastes."
